1. Cut out each shape by cutting along the outer edge of each shape
2. Fold the body and neck pieces along the dashed lines that looks like this (may be white or black):
a. The "bobble neck" part should look like an M from the side when folded (accordion fold)
3. Glue the Dino together by matching "Glue [letter]" markings
a. Glue the legs \& feet so the feet stick out in front of the Dino
4. Glue the tail on the back of the dino by putting glue on the two tabs (there are white lines where the tail should be folded)
